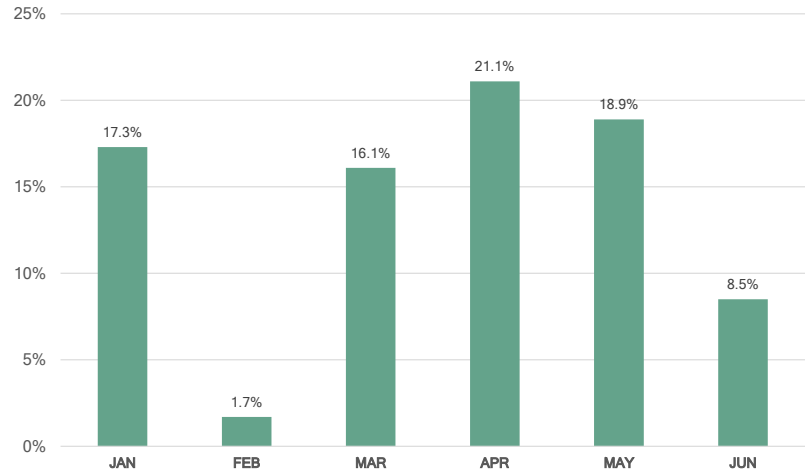


**Investment**

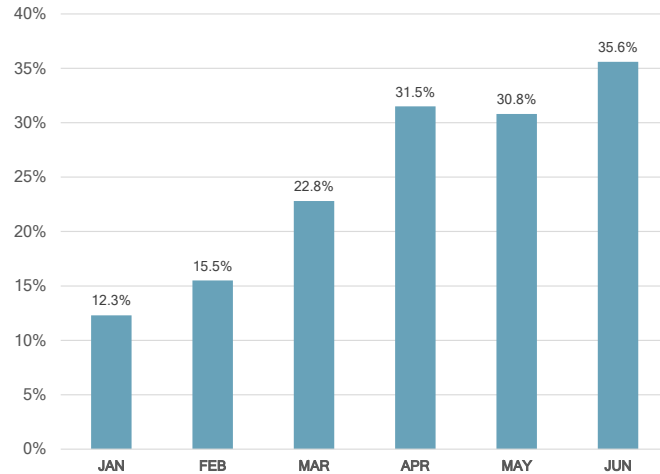
